Covid Vaccinations

As most people will have noticed, our amazing team at Trinity Court and Claverdon Surgery have been working very hard to get our patients vaccinated against COVID-19. So far we have given over 23,000 vaccinations!!! We would like to say a big thank you to all our staff, volunteers and patients for helping us to achieve these brilliant figures. You can now download the NHS App onto your smart phone to access your Covid passport. This will show you what vaccines you have had and provide proof for travel. The App also allows you to request repeat prescriptions as well as number of other useful features. Its easy to apply, just visit the the NHS App!

NHS Health Checks

We are currently inviting our patients who are between the ages of 40 and 74 to an NHS health check. You will see one of our Nurses or Health Care Assistants to have your height, weight and blood pressure checked as well as a conversation about your lifestyle. A finger prick cholesterol test is also carried out, to get an accurate reading for this, patients are asked to fast for 2 hours before their appointment. If you have received an invitation, check the NHS app to book one of these appointments! If there are no appointments available on the App, please check again in a weeks' time as we will be making more appointments available.

Alternatively, call the Practice if you have no online access.

Smears

Women over 25 years old should check whether they are due for a smear test. If you are between 25 and 49, you are due a smear every 3 years. If you are between 50 and 64 years old, you are due a smear every 5 years. 65 + will only need a test if your last 3 smears were abnormal. If you are due, then please book an appointment with one of our lovely nurses.
